Assembly this week

This week in assembly we focused on exploring our Character Traits of Integrity, Kindness and Citizenship.

We talked about these in relation to being proud of ourselves and being confident to be proud of who we are. We discussed how we may share similarities, but we are all different, special and unique and we should be proud of the things that make us different. This led us to then discuss kindness and the importance of being kind to others and respecting our differences.

Following June being Pride Month, we talked about Pride being celebration of people being proud of who they are and a reminder of treating one another with kindness and



respect. Pride is often celebrated with rainbow flags, so we read the book 'Rainbow' which shares the meaning behind the different colours of the rainbow stripes – life, healing, light, nature, harmony and spirit, and how rainbows celebrate love, hope and diversity.
