## END OF YEAR REPORTS

Next week you will be receiving your child's end of year report. This comprises of three different areas:

1. A comment from your child's Class Teacher
2. End of year assessments in relation to your child's development in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)
3. A next step linked to identified areas of learning and related suggestions for what you can be doing over summer to support your child in their transition to their new year group

Alongside the report, we will also be sharing your child's Pupil Profile. This is something that the children have completed over the last couple of weeks which captures their thoughts about the year they have had. We recommend reading your child's Pupil Profile with them and encourage them, where possible, to expand or elaborate on any of their comments and celebrate the amazing year they have had together.

Your child's Pupil Profile will be out during our Open Doors next week, however if you are unable to attend, we will send home a physical paper copy of this next week.

## CHANGEOVER DAY SUCCESS!

Yesterday was an exciting day at Crown Street as all our children - and some new children who are joining us in September - spent some time in their new classrooms with their new teaching team!

We welcomed in some of our new Pre-School children, who spent a bit of time in their classroom with the Pre-School team. Our new Reception children (including lots of our current Pre-school children plus some new children joining in September) spent some time in their new Reception classroom with the Reception Team.

Finally, our Reception children went upstairs and became Year 1s for the day and spent time in their new classroom with Miss Daniel. During the morning, the children and Miss Daniel spent some time getting to know one another, reading 'Dear Zoo', writing letters to the zoo about a possible class pet and building enclosures for different animals. Then in the afternoon, the children explored the book 'Grand Hotel of Feelings' and created some artwork linked to different feelings as they spent time discussing their feelings ahead of Year 1. Finally, to end the day I took delivery of a parcel for our new Year 1 children - a huge teddy bear and their new class pet! So, a huge welcome to Custard, who will be joining Year 1 in September!
