The End of our First Year Chapter = done ✓

Is anyone else questioning how is it the end of the academic year already? On one hand, it feels like it was September just yesterday and we were just starting the year, but then on the other, we have achieved so much across the year it makes sense that we have reached the end - time really does fly when you are having fun!

We have done it, written our first chapter of our Crown Street story, and what a wonderful chapter it has been! It all started back on Tuesday 3rd September 2024, the day Crown Street Primary School opened its doors to the first Pre-School and Reception cohort and since then our school and our community has grown and developed into a truly magical place and at the heart of it are our brilliantly amazing children, who have continued to make us all proud with the way they have adapted to life at school and embrace everything that has come their way.

They have had a phenomenal year filled with so much. We've had everything from ...learning lots of new things, our Winter and Spring Performances, welcoming in visitors to share different learning with us - including parents teaching us about their professions and sharing their religions and celebrations with us, Play & Pick-Up Sessions, visits in our local community, creating artwork, building community links, lots of outdoor play (including water, sand and mud!), growing plants,, various celebrations like World Book Day, new curriculum bookshelves, Sports Day, welcoming caterpillars and releasing butterflies, building new creations in the construction area, developing skills (like marking making, writing and Phonics), creating Pupil Profiles and as of Friday afternoon – our amazing first Summer Fair!

And there is so much more! Although all the above have been brilliant, for me the most magical part has been watching our children grow and develop. Over the last year we have:

- witnessed their incredible Bravery as they stepped into school for the first time, and then stood in front of a crowd of people to perform not once, not twice, but three times across the year developing each time (and having me in tears every time!)
- watched them developing their Citizenship by working within their House and Class Teams, and as a Crown Street Team within our local community by created beautiful artwork in collaboration with the National Trust
- watched their Curiosity spark with each new book and all the different learning opportunities they have experienced
- observed their Gratitude by seeing how they acknowledge, appreciate and celebrate one another and their achievements
- watched how they have learnt the value of sharing and being fair as well as making good choices and helping one another to do this too beginning to understand the importance of Integrity
- seen their Kindness develop as they make new friendships and learn about one another accepting and celebrating the differences between them

Thank you children – you have made Crown Street a school with such heart and we cannot wait to continue our story in September as we welcome our new cohort and see what exciting things our second year has to offer!

Another thank you needs to go to the Crown Street Team - this year would not have been the success it has been without the continued dedication and 'whatever it takes' attitude of the Crown Street Team, they are all wonderful and I am so grateful to work alongside them and for everything they do to make Crown Street the school it is.

Finally, a heartfelt thank you to all of our parent and carers for your continued support. Thank you for trusting us with such an integral year within your child's education (and continuing to do so for next year!) Many of you applied for a place before we even had a completed building, and others may have joined since we opened, but even so we were a brand-new school meaning you all had to take quite a leap of faith and trusting us means the absolute world and we look forward to developing Crown Street with you by our side.

We wish you all a relaxing and wonderful summer with whatever fun and adventures you have planned, and we look forward to welcoming you back on $Tuesday 2^{nd}$ September for the second chapter of our Crown Street story.

EXPANSION OF OUR PRE-SCHOOL PROVISION - SCHOOL-BASED NURSERY GRANT

Back in April, we shared the news that we had been successful in a bid and have received a grant to expand our Pre-School provision to offer additional Pre-School places, giving more Pre-School aged children the opportunity to join our Crown Street Primary family and be provided with 'education on another level, where possibilities are endless'.

Over the last couple of months, work has been happening behind the scenes and we are pleased to announce that plans have been confirmed and work on our new Pre-School space – a larger classroom, is now confirmed to happen over the Summer Holidays.

To allow for us to offer additional Pre-School places, we need a larger classroom which is exactly what we are going to get! We are reconfiguring some space on our ground floor, just beyond where our current Pre-School classroom is, to become a larger, open plan classroom space. This new classroom will be set up in a similar way to our current Pre-School classroom – just in a larger space – with a carpet / whole-class teaching space and various different areas to provide different learning opportunities (E.g. Reading area, Home Corner, Construction Area, Creative Station etc.). It will also have a cloakroom space and toilets in a bathroom space within the wider classroom. The classroom will also have direct access to the Early Years outside area, which will continue to be shared with Reception.

Although the work is set to be completed by the end of August, to give us a safety net (incase of any issues – because you never know), and to give us time to set up the new classroom in a way that will work for our children, and ensure that all furniture and resources are in place, we will not be using this classroom space until after October half-term.

So, for September this means nothing will change – our new Pre-School children will continue to use the current Pre-School classroom. Then during the first half term we will ensure we provide opportunities for our Pre-School children to visit the new classroom space, ensuring a smooth transition as they then hopefully move into it after half-term.

In addition to our Pre-School moving into a new classroom, we are hoping that we are able to do a bit more reconfiguration and then utilise the current Pre-School classroom as additional space for our Reception class – but more to come on this in the Autumn term.


