Autumn Walk

Can you draw a picture of some of the things you heard? Can you write the initial sound too?

Where is the most interesting or unusual place you can read? Can you make a video and retell one of the stories?

Construction Challenge



Can you build a bridge strong enough to hold a toy? Use objects you have at home. Can you make a house for your toy too?
