#### PLAYGROUND UPDATE

Since opening the school last September, something that we have been working on developing is our rooftop playground. We want the space to be an inviting space where our children are able to play and enjoy their time together at playtime and lunchtime.

Despite it being our playground, it is not necessarily the 'usual' school playground and with it being on the roof there have been some additional complexities to what we can have within the space and how it can be fitted. So, we have been working with Pentagon Play UK (who previously fitted our astro turf) to make the space a bit 'greener' and add some equipment that works within the space and that we are sure our children will love to use.

#### PARENT COUNCIL

Next week, we will be holding our first Parent Council meeting this year. The purpose of Parent Council is to provide a constructive forum for sharing feedback about what's gone well, and also any suggestions for what could be better in the future.

### Healthy Eating Guidance for Pre-**School and Reception**

There has been an update to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Framework Nutrition Guidance that applies to school meals, snacks and food in Kids Club for both Pre-School and Reception classes. Our catering partner, Dolce, has updated menus to reflect updated standards. Key changes include:

- Reducing added sugars (e.g., plain yoghurt instead of sweetened)
- Using wholemeal bread for sandwiches
- Updating staff on portion sizes

These changes help us provide healthy, balanced options for meals, snacks, and drinks for our youngest pupils.
